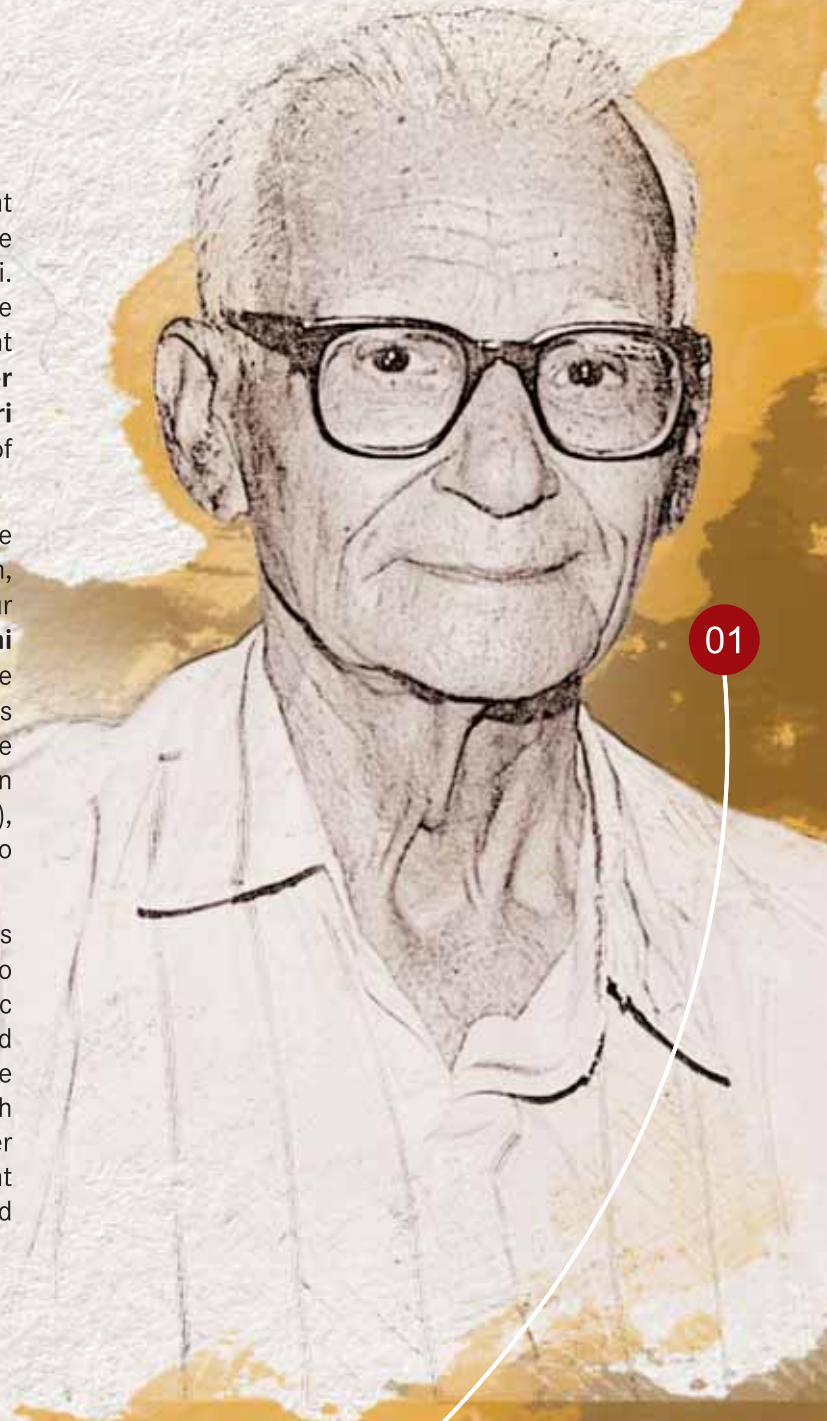


Vision & Visionaries

The school becomes a platform for free and meaningful interaction between the teachers and students to create a healthy learning environment. It provides a superior education to create a big impact on young, impressionable minds.



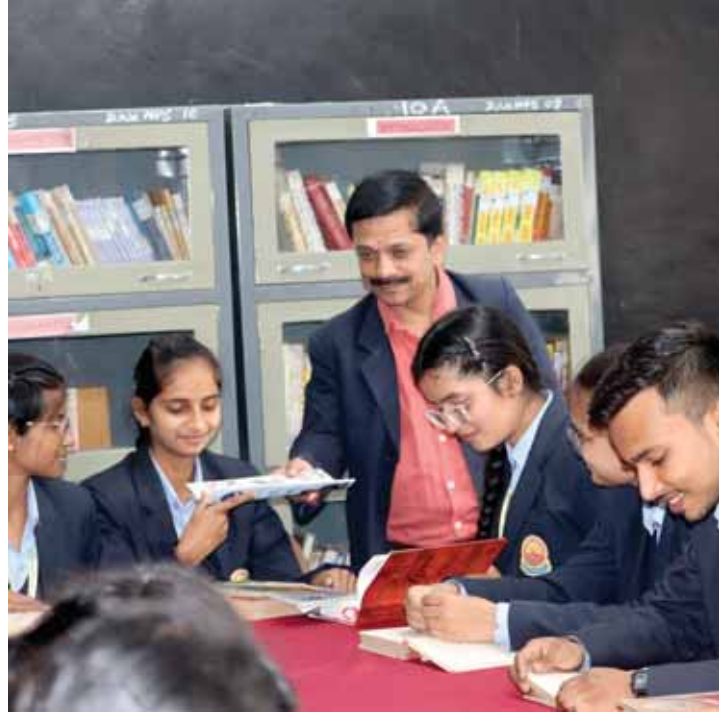

Participative Management



Registration & Admission

- The Prospectus & Registration Form for admission to the school can be obtained from the school office.
- Admission form is also available, online, at our school website (www.davnmps.com).
- It should be duly filled and submitted with the required documents and certificates as mentioned in the form.
- Registration fee is non-refundable and registration is no guarantee for admission.
- Special consideration is given to Transfer cases and BPL Students.
- Birth Certificate issued by competent authorities and Transfer Certificate obtained from the previous school are essential at the time of admission.
- Fees must be deposited within the stipulated dates, failing which the particular candidate may not be considered for admission





School Uniform

A uniform fosters a sense of unity and community amongst students. All students are required to wear their designated uniforms to school every day unless otherwise instructed.

Age Criteria

The basic age criteria for admission to classes Nursery & Prep (Informal Education) and class 1 (Formal Education) is to be met according to the birth certificate issued by the Municipal Corporation or any other competent authority as given herewith.

Identity card

An identity card bearing a passport size photograph and the address of the student should always remain in their possession.



Attendance

- 75% attendance is essential **for promotion** to the next class.
- No leave is granted except on prior application from parents /guardians for genuine reasons.
- In case of sickness, a medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner has to be submitted.
- Repeated absence without leave or unexplained leave for fifteen consecutive days renders a student liable to have the name struck off the rolls. Such students will be readmitted after they pay readmission charges.
- It is compulsory for students to attend school on the first and the last day after Summer Vacation, Puja Vacation, and Winter Vacation.
- Leave application has to be submitted to the class teacher for prior information or else the student will be fined.





Guidelines for Students

- Students must come to school in neatly laundered uniform and polished shoes. . Girls with long hair should make plaits. They should not wear any jewellery, have long nails or apply nail polish / kajal, mehendi when they come to school. Coloured clips, hairbands are not permitted. Boys are not allowed to wear any jewellery, tattoos or have long nails when they come to school. They must have a proper haircut/clean shave at all times.
- Every student is required to carry the school identity card each day of the school.
- A student must speak in decent language all the time. He must ensure that his speech is courteous and polite.
- Students should not bully any other student. Bullying through physical intimidation or attacks, verbal abuse, unwanted attention and advances, damaging property, spreading malicious rumours, sending unpleasant S.M.S., messages, photographs or E-mails to others etc. is strictly prohibited. If any student is found indulging in any of the above offensive behaviour, strict action will be taken by the school management leading to expulsion or rustication from the school.
- A minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory to be eligible to appear in the examination.
- Care must be taken of all the school property and students should not spoil the desks or chairs or damage any school furniture. Negligent students will be charged for the damage. Grave insubordination, discourtesy or disrespect to teachers, contempt of authority, willful damage to the property or physical violence will result in dismissal from the school. No student is permitted to use rude, abusive or inappropriate language in the school premises.
- Students should obey House prefects, Class monitors and other students on duty
- Permitted vehicles must be kept locked. Riding cycles or motor bike on the school premises is strictly prohibited.
- The school will not be responsible for any goods lost. Students are advised not to bring valuables like costly watches and fountain pen etc.
- Students must actively participate in classroom discussions/ interactions. Every student must take part in all the curricular and co-curricular activities, sports and national social programs as planned by the school, unless declared unfit or exempted by the authorities.

Guidelines for Parents

- Parents/guardians are requested to check the school almanac of their ward daily and note the instructions / Remarks made in it. It should be seen and countersigned by parents daily as a proof that remarks have been read. Failure to do so may defeat the purpose of remarks.
- Parents must ensure that the things which are strictly banned in the school should not be provided to their wards, such as electronic gadgets, camera, mobiles. If caught, it will not be returned, even to the parents.
- Parents must ensure that their ward do not bring any valuable items to school. The school will not take any responsibility, in case of loss.
- Taking leave during working days is strongly discouraged. Parents are responsible to make up for the loss of studies in case of leave taken. The school will expect these students to be at par with the class in every way and that will have to be ensured by the parents.
- For the best result parents must motivate and support their child establish a proper study area. Home work must be given a priority in the daily schedule. Please motivate your ward to speak in English.
- Criticism of a teacher of the school in presence of a child must be scrupulously avoided as it causes students to lose respect for their teacher with the consequent failure to learn from him/her, thus retarding the child's progress.
- Parents can meet the Principal and teachers during the visiting hours. Please do not try to contact Principal or teachers at their residence.
- The school rules should first be followed by the parents such as paying fee on time, attending all PTMs, coming to school on call from teachers. Students will adhere the positive response and act accordingly.
- Involve your ward in household chores at least to channelize their energy in constructive work. It will also reduce aggression in them.
- Parents are requested to inform the school if there is any change in address/ Tel. numbers.
- Withdrawal from any class must be preceded by a month's notice in writing or a month's fee in lieu of notice.
 - All dues must be cleared before a Transfer Certificate is issued.
 - Transfer Certificate will be issued one week after the receipt of the application.
- The parents may be asked by the school authorities to withdraw their child from the school, without prior notice, based on any of the following grounds:
 - a) Academic: Constant neglect of studies, such as those students who fail in the same class for two consecutive years.
 - b) Disciplinary: Conduct of the students being found harmful to the interests of the school in the opinion of the Principal.
- Parents must educate their children regarding use of internet and caution them against use of Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, Whatsapp, etc., so that they remain isolated from Cyber Bullying, addiction to internet and such other negative effects.

Transport

The School provides transport facilities as per the convenience of the children. The transport routes have been specified and buses ply accordingly.
