- Your story must have a catchy title, interesting characters, clear setting, problem or conflict, solution, meaningful ending and moral or message, if applicable.
- Must be written in your best handwriting and neatness and readability are essential.
- Use correct grammar, paragraphs, proper punctuation, and check spellings.
- The story must be 100% original and written by you. Stories generated from the internet or copied from books will not be accepted.

 - Draw a picture or take a photo (with permission) of each.
- **Reflection:** Think about how these plants and animals are important to the environment.
- How do they depend on each other? Write a short paragraph about your thoughts.

NOTE: prepare front page, acknowledgement, index, contents and bibliography. Submit in STICK FILE within the time limit.

Topic : Sources of History Scrapbook
